



The Medical Convoy in Mansheyat Hatem Village in Zefta District on Saturday, November 13, 2021

Under patronage Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Hamdy Ismael Shaaban, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the General Administration of Environmental Projects at the Sector of Community Service and organized Environmental Tanta University Development of comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Mansheyat Hatem village in Zefta district on Saturday, November 13, 2021 under the umbrella of the presidential initiative Decent Life that aims to achieve sustainable development in Egyptian rural areas and to help the neediest citizens. The convoy was organized in cooperation with executive bodies in Gharbia governorate.

The convoy was held with participation of faculties of Medicine, Pharmacy, and Nursing, Tanta University. Medicaments were offered for free in various medical specialties in attendance of academic staff and doctors who took part in the convoy. 827 patients were examined as the convoy aimed to provide a great number of citizens with health care services to fulfil the university's role in health, social, environmental and





intellectual development and to benefit from its efficient specialized cadres in presenting quality medical care to the needy and in remote places.

Prof. Mohammed Al-Shebiny declared that 42 patients were transferred to University Hospitals to continue their treatment in specialties of chest, cardiology, general surgery, ophthalmology, orthopedic surgery and urology.

Furthermore, in cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the university organized a veterinary convoy where medicaments of the examined animals were distributed for free.

Moreover, Faculty of Nursing organized a cultural convoy for citizens of the village where outreach symposiums were held following all precautions against COVID-19.

The Medical Convoy

The convoy was inaugurated by Prof. Tarek Rahmy, Gharbia Governor, and Prof. Hamdy Ismael Shaaban, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development. It was prepared under supervision of Prof. Mohammed Al-Shebiny, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development. The inauguration was attended by Prof. Al-Shebiny, Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community Service and Environmental Development; Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects, and Mr. Maher Hosny Saad, General





Manager of Community Service, as well as doctors who participated in the convoy and examined 827 patients.
