Report on convoy No. 59 sent to Al-'Aysha village in Zefta district
on February 15, 2020

Under patronage of Prof. Magdi Sab', University President, and Prof. 'Emad 'Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical convoy in Al-'Aysha village in Zefta district on February 15, 2020. It was inaugurated by Prof. Ahmed Zaki Mansour, Prof. Sahar Mohey Al-Din Hazza', Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development; and Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community Service and Environmental Development, in attendance of Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects, and Mr. Maher Hossny Sa'd, General Manager of Community Service.

Patients who visited the clinics were examined and given medicaments for free. They were 1560 cases. 43 of them were transferred to University Hospital to get needed checks and to continue treatment for free.

During the convoy, lectures on environmental awareness were given. Prof. Sahar Hazza', Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University, delivered a lecture on infection control, its causes, common diseases in this period of the year, how to detect coronavirus, methods of prevention and how to control its infection. In addition, Prof. Tarek Mohammed Mustafa from

Faculty of Pharmacy, Tanta University, gave a lecture entitled “Misuse of Medicaments in Society”. Prof. Ayman Abdel Hamid Nagy from Toxin Treatment Center at Faculty of Medicine, Tanta University, gave a lecture on “Awareness about Hazardous Toxins in Society” as well as other lectures by academic staff from Faculty of Nursing, Tanta University. Moreover, Ms. Shimaa Sheikhon from Environmental Affairs Agency delivered a lecture on the importance of water and water preservation.

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the University organized a veterinary convoy where medicaments of examined animals were distributed for free.

The total cost of comprehensive medical convoy in Al-‘Aysha village in Zefta district was 150 thousand pounds.

In the framework of participation of Tanta University in the presidential initiative “Go Green”, the University planted many fruitful trees in the village and in the adjacent villages.

In cooperation with the General Authority for Literacy and Adult Education, a classroom for literacy was inaugurated in the village. 16 citizens applied for literacy test.

As part of the Social Solidarity Convoy and in cooperation with the University and Social Affairs Sector, Social Solidarity Directorate considered needy cases and distributed 150 blankets to 150 poor families in the village.

Furthermore, Faculty of Specific Education and Faculty of Physical Education took part in the convoy and discovered 23 talented students.
