A symposium was held by Community Service and Environmental
Development Sector under the title “No Drugs” in cooperation with the
Fund for Drug Control & Treatment of Addiction (FDCTA) affiliated to
Prime Minister’s Office on Thursday, November 12, 2020.

The symposium was inaugurated by Prof. Kamal Okasha, University
Vice President for Postgraduate Studies and Research. In his speech,
Prof. Okasha affirmed the importance of taking all precautions to curb
COVID-19 and the significance of disseminating awareness about
hazards of addiction and drugs.

Prof. Mohammed Al-Sayed, Acting Dean of Faculty of Agriculture,
highlighted the importance of not starting to take drugs, not to continue
taking them and seeking treatment.

Moreover, lectures were given by Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz,
General Supervisor of Preventive Programs at Gharbia Governorate and
Research at FDCTA; Prof. Mohammed Mustafa Mohammed, Expert of

Toxicology and Drugs at Forensic Medicine Authority at Ministry of Justice and Consultant of FDCTA; and Prof. Ahmed Abdel Sattar Al-Ebiary, Professor of Clinical Toxicology at Faculty of Medicine at Tanta University. They delivered speeches on dangers of addition as well as smoking, its hazards and how to stop smoking.
