**Description:**

Tanta University has a policy for safety, convenience, and disabled-friendly pedestrian paths, this policy is reflected in campus pedestrian paths facilities and features.

These facilities and features are as follows:

1- Inside Tanta University campuses there are Separators between roads for vehicles and pedestrian paths.

2- Pedestrian paths inside Tanta University campuses are provided with ramps and guiding blocks which have suitable design for pedestrians having physical disabilities.

3- Pedestrian paths inside Tanta University campuses are provided with road signs to indicate places, directions, and riding instructions.

4- Pedestrian paths inside Tanta University campuses are provided with streetlamps for pedestrians at night.
