#### **The Medical Convoy**

Patients who visited the clinics were examined. They were 536 cases. There were 12 doctors who are academic staff at Faculty of Medicine in addition to some academic staff from Faculty of Pharmacy who supervised distribution of medicaments that costed 25 thousand pounds. Patients got these medicaments for free.
