Patients who visited the clinics were examined. They were 641 cases. There were 11 doctors from academic staff of Faculty of Medicine in addition to some academic staff from Faculty of Pharmacy who supervised distribution of medicaments that costed 25 thousand pounds. Patients got these medicaments for free.
