Report on the Convoy No. 64 in Kafr Abo Gendy Village in Qutor District on Sunday, October 18, 2020

The Medical Convoy

Patients who visited the clinics were examined. They were 644 cases. There were 11 doctors who are academic staff at Faculty of Medicine in addition to some academic staff from Faculty of

Pharmacy who supervised distribution of medicaments that costed 35 thousand pounds. Patients got these medicaments for free.

The Veterinary Convoy

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the University organized a veterinary convoy in the village where medicaments of examined animals were distributed for free.
