Report on the comprehensive medical convoy No. 58 in Kotama village in Basyoun district on Thursday, February 6, 2020

Under patronage of Prof. Magdi Sab', University President, and Prof. 'Emad 'Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical convoy in Kotama village in Basyoun district on Thursday, February 6, 2020.

The convoy was inaugurated by Prof. Ahmed Zaki Mansour, Prof. Sahar Mohey Al-Din Hazza', Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development; and Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community Service and Environmental Development, in attendance of Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects; Mr. Maher Hossny Sa'd, General Manager of Community Service; and Mr. Ashraf Al-Haddad, Media Official of Environmental Affairs Agency.

Patients who visited the clinics were examined and given medicaments for free. They were 1790 cases. 21 of them were transferred to University Hospital to get needed checks and to continue treatment for free.

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the University organized a veterinary convoy where medicaments of examined animals were distributed for free.

The total cost of comprehensive medical convoy comprehensive medical convoy in Kotama village in Basyoun district was about 150 thousand pounds.

During the convoy, some lectures were given about topics that village community is interested in and methods of dealing with them in attendance of academic staff from faculties of Nursing and Specific Education and deputy of Environmental Affairs Agency. Prof. Sahar Hazza', Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University, delivered a lecture on infection control, its causes, common diseases in this period of the year, how to detect coronavirus, methods of prevention and how to control its infection. Moreover, Dr. Nagwa Al-Bendary from Department of Educational Media at Faculty of Specific Education, Tanta University, delivered a lecture entitled "We are all against bullying". Mr. Ashraf Al-Haddad from Environmental Affairs Agency gave a lecture on the presidential initiative "Go Green" that was launched by Ministry of Environment.

In collaboration with the General Authority for Literacy and Adult Education, a classroom was inaugurated in the village. 37 citizens applied for literacy test.

As part of the Social Solidarity Convoy and in cooperation with the University and Social Affairs Sector, the Social Solidarity Directorate considered needy cases and distributed 150 blankets to 150 poor families in the village.
