

A Comprehensive Environmental Medical Convoy to Salhagar Village and Adjacent Villages and Hamlets in Basyoun District in January 2019

To affirm the effective role played by the University in community service and environmental development, Tanta University organized a comprehensive environmental medical convoy to Salhaga village in Basyoun district in Gharbia governorate on Sunday, January 27, 2019 under patronage of Prof. Magdi Sab', University President; and Prof. 'Emad 'Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development; in cooperation with Gharbia Governorate and related bodies in the governorate namely Al-Mahalla City Council, Education Directorate, Health Affairs Directorate, Social Solidarity Directorate, Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the General Authority for Literacy and Adult Education, and Environmental Affairs Agency.

The convoy was inaugurated by Prof. Ahmed Zaki Mansour, Representative of the University; Prof. Sahar Mohey Al-Din, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development; Mr. Abdel Shafy Mustafa Abdel Shafy, Chairman of Basyoun City Council; Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazi, General Manager of Environmental Projects at the University; and Mr. Maher Hosny Sa'd, General Manager of Community Service at the University.

33 doctors with different medical specialties participated in the convoy. Medicaments that cost 60 thousand pounds were distributed for free to patients. 24 cases were transferred to University Hospital to continue their treatment.
