

Convoy No. 73 in Shobra Al-Yaman Village in Zefta District on Thursday, February 16, 2021



Under patronage Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Emad Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the General Administration of Environmental Projects at Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Shobra Al-Yaman Village in Zefta District on Thursday, February 16, 2021.

It was inaugurated by Prof. Sahar Mohey Al-Din Hazaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development, and Prof. Mohamed Maamoon Al-Sheikh, Vice Dean of Faculty of Dentistry for Community Service and Environmental Development, in attendance of Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects, and Mr. Maher Hosny Saad, General Manager of Community Service.

1047 patients visited the clinics. They were examined and were given medicaments for free. These medicaments cost 50 thousand pounds. Moreover, a special dentistry vehicle was prepared in cooperation with Faculty of Dentistry.

The Medical Convoy

The Medical Convoy was inaugurated by vice deans of faculties of Medicine and Dentistry. Doctors examined the patients and pharmacists supervised distribution of medicaments for free to 1047 patients who visited the clinics.
