



Convoy No. 75 in Mit-Alsudan Village in Tanta District on Wednesday,
April 7, 2021

Under patronage Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Emad Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the Sector of Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Mit-Alsudan Village in Tanta District on Wednesday, April 7, 2021. The convoy was inaugurated by Prof. Sahar Mohey Al-Din Hazzaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development; Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community Service and Environmental Development; Prof. Mohammed Maamoon Al-Sheikh, Vice Dean of Faculty of Dentistry for Community Service and Environmental Development; in attendance of Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects, and Mr. Maher Hosny Saad, General Manager of Community Service.

Medicaments were given for free to 1127 patients who were examined at the clinics of the convoy. These medicaments cost 50000 EGP. There was a dentistry vehicle in cooperation with Faculty of Dentistry.



In addition, Faculty of Nursing participated in the comprehensive convoy to Mit-Alsudan to disseminate awareness about preventive measures such as social distancing. Symposiums were held about COVID-19, its symptoms, precautions, and how to deal with patients in home quarantine.

The Medical Convoy

The convoy was inaugurated by vice deans for community service and environmental development from faculties of Medicine, Pharmacy, and Dentistry, as well as doctors and pharmacists who distributed medicaments to 1127 patients who visited the clinics and were examined.

The Veterinary Convoy

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the university organized a veterinary convoy. Medicaments of examined animals were distributed for free. These medicaments cost 8000 EGP.
