



<u>Convoy No. 78 in Hanoot Village in Zefta District on Thursday,</u> June 10, 2021

Under patronage of Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Emad Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the Sector of Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Hanoot Village in Zefta District on Thursday, June 10, 2021, in the framework of the presidential initiative Decent Life that aims to achieve sustainable development in Egyptian rural areas and to relieve the suffering of the neediest citizens.

The convoy was organized with participation of faculties of Medicine, Pharmacy, and Nursing in attendance of academic staff members of various specialties. Medical examination was conducted and required medicaments were given for free to 945 patients. The convoy aims to offer health care services to a great number of citizens and to give them needed medicaments to achieve health, social, environmental, and awareness development in remote areas in implementation of the social role and developmental mission of the University.

The Medical Convoy

The convoy was prepared under supervision of Prof. Sahar Hazzaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental





Development, who inaugurated the convoy in attendance of Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community Service and Environmental Development, and Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects. During the convoy, 945 patients visited the clinics and were examined.











The Veterinary Convoy

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate in the village, the university organized a veterinary convoy as part of the presidential initiative Decent Life for development of Egyptian rural areas. Medicaments of examined animals were distributed for free.
