



Convoy No. 84 in Hanon Village in Zefta District on Sunday, August 1, 2021

Under patronage Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Emad Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the Sector of Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Hanon village in Zefta district on Sunday, August 1, 2021 under the umbrella of the presidential initiative *Decent Life* that aims to make sustainable development in Egyptian rural areas to help the needlest citizens. The convoy was organized in cooperation with executive bodies in Gharbia governorate namely Education Directorate, Health Directorate, and Veterinary Medicine Directorate.

The convoy was organized with participation of faculties of Medicine and Pharmacy, Tanta University. Medicaments were offered for free in various medical specialties in attendance of academic staff and doctors who took part in the convoy. 1095





patients were examined as the convoy aimed to provide a great number of citizens with health care services to carry out the role of the university in health, social, environmental and intellectual development and to benefit from its efficient specialized cadres in presenting quality medical care to the needy and in remote places.

Moreover, Prof. Sahar Hazzaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development, declared that there was an equipped ambulance allocated for the medical convoys of *Decent Life* initiative in Zefta.

In addition, 14 patients were transferred to University Hospitals in specialties of cardiology, general surgery, and internal medicine to be followed up and operated on soon.

Furthermore, in cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the university organized a veterinary convoy where medicaments of the examined animals were distributed for free.





The Medical Convoy
