



<u>Convoy No. 85 in Mit Al-Mokhles Village in Zefta District on</u> <u>Sunday, August 8, 2021</u>

Under patronage Prof. Mahmoud Zaki, Tanta University President, and Prof. Emad Etman, University Vice President for Community Service and Environmental Development, the Sector of Community Service and Environmental Development at Tanta University organized a comprehensive medical and environmental convoy in Mit Al-Mokhles village in Zefta district on Sunday, August 8, 2021 under the umbrella of the presidential initiative *Decent Life* that aims to make sustainable development in Egyptian rural areas to help the neediest citizens. The convoy was organized in cooperation with executive bodies in Gharbia governorate namely Education Directorate, Health Directorate, and Veterinary Medicine Directorate.

The convoy was organized with participation of faculties of Medicine, Pharmacy, and Nursing, Tanta University. Medicaments were offered for free in various medical specialties in attendance of academic staff and doctors who took part in the





convoy. 1086 patients were examined as the convoy aimed to provide a great number of citizens with health care services to carry out the role of the university in health, social, environmental and intellectual development and to benefit from its efficient specialized cadres in presenting quality medical care to the needy and in remote places.

Moreover, Prof. Sahar Hazzaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development, declared that 18 patients were transferred to University Hospitals to complete their treatment in specialties of general surgery, burns, ophthalmology, and orthopedic surgery.

Furthermore, in cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the university organized a veterinary convoy where medicaments of the examined animals were distributed for free.

The Medical Convoy

The convoy was prepared under supervision of Prof. Sahar Hazzaa, Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine for Community Service and Environmental Development, who inaugurated the convoy in attendance of Prof. Sahar Al-Haggar, Vice Dean of Faculty of Pharmacy for Community





Service and Environmental Development; Mr. Mohammed Abdel Aziz Ghazy, General Manager of Environmental Projects, and Mr. Maher Hosny Saad, General Manager of Community Service, as well as doctors who participated in the convoy and examined 1086 patients.









The Veterinary Convoy

In cooperation with Veterinary Medicine Directorate, the university organized a veterinary convoy in the village as part of the presidential initiative Decent Life – Egyptian Countryside Development where medicaments of the examined animals were distributed for free.
