
Institution History and Strategic Goals


Mission

SWOT analysis FINDINGS

The most prominent challenges facing Tanta University, such as those facing the higher education sector:

- (1) The Challenges facing the application of quality and accreditation.
- (2) Imbalances in graduates relative to the requirements of the labor market.
- (3) Challenges of raising university research capabilities and innovation.

The SWOT analysis highlighted the need **to improve the system and quality of the educational process and vocational training and link it to the labor market, as well as the need to strengthen university research capabilities and support innovation and entrepreneurship.**

Tanta University's strategy

aims to ensure that university graduates have the qualifications required in the Egyptian and Arab labor markets.






2- Tanta University Publications by subject (2018-2023)


3- Tanta University Publications by journal quartile (2018-2023)



According to shown figures the higher quartile of university's publications located from 2020 to 2023




Collaboration as a part of Tanta University's strategy was adopted by the research and higher studies sector. About 80 % of university publications were presented in collaboration with both international and national institutes.






Sustainability Plans






